Councillor Smith advised that two Police Officers had attended at Meadowfield following reports of anti-social behaviour.

Minutes

Parish Precept 2024/2025

The Clerk reported the receipt of correspondence from Durham County Council providing details of the Parish Tax Base, together with a request for the Parish Precept for the financial year 2024/2025. The Local Tax Reduction Scheme Grant for 2024/2025 is £475.

The Clerk then provided details of the Parish Council's overall financial position, including details of future expenditure.

Resolved that the Parish Council agrees to a Precept in the sum of £8,200 for the financial year 2024/2025.

- Durham County Council New Play Area Members examined four plans in respect of alternative schemes.

The Clerk then explained that, during a recent site inspection, it was found that one of the existing pieces of play equipment represented a safety risk. Following consultations with the Chair it had been agreed that Durham County Council should be asked to carry out the necessary repairs as soon as possible.
