Police Report

PCSO Jackson-Cullen presented the following Police report:-

- Motorbikes stolen 8th September 2018 recovered after being abandoned. It appears to have been "joyriders".
- Motorbikes confiscated from two youths and crushed.
- Traffic Police have been active in the village. Drivers have been caught with no MOT or insurance. One driver has been charged with several road traffic offences. More days of action are planned.

Community Centre Report
